Following the success of the second Design Awards in 2018, the Canterbury Society is now seeking sponsors for our next Design Awards in 2021. The Canterbury Society Design Awards aim to recognise and celebrate buildings, spaces and places that are loved by our community. The Awards celebrate projects nominated by the people who live alongside them and use them and who have a real understanding of their impact on the local area.

Back in 2018, The King's School won the top prize, taking the "Overall Winner" title and also two others for its Kingsdown House development on Broad Street.

Other category winners included a private dwelling at 8, St Peter's Lane, by CPD Architect's in the "New Housing" category, The Sibson Building, University of Kent, by Penoyre and Prasad in the "New Building outside a Conservation Area" category and the Chapter House Pizzeria and Bar, by Clague Architects in the "Shop Fronts and Signage" category.

Plaques were presented to the winners by the Society's President, Ptolemy Dean who also gave an entertaining talk on "Working to SAVE Canterbury's Heritage".

The event is publicised widely on our website, Facebook page and in the Canterbury News in addition to the local press. A brochure, containing information about the event, the judging panel and all the category winners is also published on line and in a hard souvenir copy.

For our CSDA2021, we are planning to call for nominations during the spring and hold our prestigious Design Awards Ceremony at the Cathedral Lodge on 9<sup>th</sup> November where the winners will be announced.
